Dow Increases Prices for Vinyl Acetate Monomer in All Regions

Midland, MI -- The Dow Chemical Company announced that it will increase off-list selling prices for vinyl acetate monomer in Latin America by US\$150 per metric ton; in Asia Pacific by US\$150 per metric ton; in Europe by 110 Euros per metric ton; and in the Middle East/Africa by US\$150 per metric ton. In the United States and Canada, list and off-list prices will increase by \$0.06 per pound. This price increase is effective immediately or as otherwise allowed by individual contract terms.
