Franklin International is committed to delivering quality products at competitive pricing and we are very sensitive to our customers that must compete in their markets. Over the course of the past several months, we have realized increases in costs on raw materials, packaging, labor and overall general operations. High demand of raw materials and packaging supplies has created shortages in many sectors, which has resulted in escalated product costs. We have absorbed these costs over many months but the increases are expected to continue and they have made it necessary for us to announce a price increase on all products.

Specifically related to wood glue technology:

- Strong vinyl acetate & acetic acid demand combined with tight supply resulting in one major supplier announcing 100% sales control and raising costs with minimal notice.
- Pricing for key feedstocks (ethylene and methanol) used to make vinyl acetate for wood glues have been on the rise since Q4
  and are expected to continue into 2021. Spot ethylene is currently trading near a six year high and methanol a two year high.
- Force Majeure on methyl methacrylate impacting 17% of all US demand.
- Worldwide shortage of MDI is impacting availability and costs globally.
- Strong demand forecasted well into 2021 will continue to pressure all raw material costs and supply.

As such, Franklin is implementing a price increase on orders placed after February 5<sup>th</sup> and all shipments after March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021. Franklin is currently at three weeks lead time on top selling items due to industry wide raw material shortages and high demand. Orders received after February 5<sup>th</sup> are likely not to ship until after March 1<sup>st</sup> thus the early price change. We will not allow additional orders or additional quantities out of your normal order patterns during this time frame. We are asking our customers to work with their assigned account managers for the best outcomes during this difficult time.
