Dear Distributor:

Franklin International is continuing to absorb large increases in costs on intermediate chemicals. Intermediates are commonly known as additives such as surfactants, thickeners, solvents, dispersants, plasticizers and similar chemicals used in the formulations of vinyl acetate based glues. Although Franklin has already passed on a very moderate price increase on drum and tote sized packages, followed by a \$0.04 surcharge, we find ourselves having to increase water-based glues an additional \$0.03 - .05 effective August 1st, 2021. The impacted brands include but are not limited to: Advantage, Multibond, Titebond, Doorbond, Woodbond, Assembly and Lamination glues.

Specifically related to water based adhesives as of June 8th 2021:

- Strong adhesive demand continues to pressure available capacity of intermediary chemicals.
- Pricing for key feedstocks (methanol and ethylene) although currently falling, have been offset by supply constraints.
- The US region is now the highest priced region for spot prices of vinyl acetate.
- Force Majeure has been declared by Dover Chemical, tightening the supply of Chlorinated Olefins.
- Strong demand forecasted well into 2021 will continue to pressure all raw material costs and supply.

Franklin is currently at 6-8 weeks lead time due to industry wide raw material shortages and high demand. Orders received after June 21st are likely not to ship until after August 1st thus requiring the new pricing on orders. Franklin is asking our customers to work with their assigned customer service managers for additional clarifications if needed.
